IMPORTANT INSTRUCTION TO CANDIDATE

Visually disabled candidates (and such Physically disabled candidates who are unable to write) appearing in SET-2017 Examination would be allowed 25 minutes Compensatory time separately for papers I & II and 50 minutes compensatory time for Paper III. Besides, they would be provided with a writer if prior intimation is given to the Officer-in-Charge of the Centre at least one week before the date of the examination. The academic qualification of the Writer should not be above the Graduate level, and he/she should be from a different subject than that of the candidate. The Test Centre will provide the Writer's remuneration Rs. 500/- (including tiffin) after completion of the SET-2017 Examination. The candidate may also bring a writer at his/her own cost, but the writers' credentials should be properly verified by the Officer-in-Charge of the respective Test Centre.

Any replacement of the Test Centre and Change of subject should not be allowed under any circumstances.

Correction regarding Application Form will be accepted only upto 24th November, 2017 and thereafter no such correction will be accepted.
